

CLASSIFIED PAGINATION

Fast, Easy, Flexible

A single click paginates an entire page or section. The system creates a separate file of each ad, allowing point-and-click movement of ad placement if desired, as well as insertion or deletion of individual "late" ads that might need to be inserted.

Version Improvements

Sends ad placement information back to the Vision Total Advertising system for permanent storage.

Easily Handles Long or Multi-Column Ads

Ads running longer than one column can be "flowed" which automatically "breaks" the ads to fit columns, adding a "jump line tag" at the newspaper's discretion.

EPS, PDF, or JPEG Dump, PC or Mac Compatible

Performs equally well on either PC or Mac, with optional EPS, PDF, or JPEG dump, allowing user to view previews of the finished pages.

Save or Print a Copy as You Go

Can be restarted from the point of the last saved location.

Enhanced Session Preferences

Preferences allow the user to browse files and folders instead of having to type in paths by hand.

Multiple Session Capabilities

Paginate multiple sessions at once on the same machine allowing storage of multiple sets of permanent network pointers, eliminating the need to move files to paginate different publications

Color Ads

Color classified and display ads have a different look than other ads on the screen.



- Vision Classified Pagination provides automated dateline and page numbering capabilities
- Facing pages can be viewed in tandem when working on either of them
- Column rules can now be inserted from the menu for added flexibility
- Rules are eliminated above headers and reformatted to remain outside of multi-column ads
- Filler duplication eliminated by randomizing filler
 placement
- Fillers can be inserted at either top or bottom of column
- Paginate back to front or front to back
- Alpha characters can be used with numeric classification codes for maximum flexibility
- Single column display ads can flow optionally incolumn as do liners
- Section headers can be included when there are no ads in the following classification or when it contains all classified display and no liner ads
